

Waste Specification



ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Children's garden toys
- Bread crates
- Milk crates
- Storage boxes / crates
- Trays
- Tubs
- Pallets
- Buckets
- Rigid plant pots
- Dustbins
- 5 – 205 litre drums
- Water butts
- Utility / water piping (Polypropylene, PP and High Density Polyethylene, HDPE)
- Wheelie bins
- Car bumpers
- Bottle banks (cut up)
- PVC guttering, down pipes, fascias, soffits (black, white, brown, grey)
- UPVC window frames, doors
- Garden furniture
- Electrical children's toys
- PVC pipe

All materials must be consigned in accordance with the Duty of Care Regulations and the Environmental Protection Act and must be accompanied with the correct paperwork.



UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- Takeaway food trays
- Baby seats
- Baths
- Plastic products with textile, padding and metal frames still attached
- Plastic film
- Polythene carrier bags
- Electrical goods TV's, computer items, hair dryers, vacuum cleaners, etc...
- Video / cassette tapes
- Lightweight flower pots
- Plastic bottles (milk, water etc.)

Plastic loads mixed with the following materials will be **unaccepted**:

Wood, metal, cardboard, paper, inert material (concrete, soils), acrylic items, chemicals / oils, paint, fibre glass products, textiles, general waste, green waste, bulky waste (mattresses, sofas), plasterboard.

Special arrangements and rebates can be agreed for separated at source loads of e.g. wheelie bins, drums, car bumpers and crates.

All loads will be inspected prior to and upon tipping. Any load found to be contaminated will be deemed as unacceptable and rejected. The delivery driver will be informed and given photographic evidence showing the reason for the rejection.
