

WE CAN ONLY RECYCLE CLEAN, DRY PLASTERBOARD

Acceptable Items

Plasterboard must be loose & not in plastic sacks

Plasterboard must be dry. Loads containing wet material may be rejected

Foam or insulation-backed plasterboard must be handled separately. It can be recycled but it will attract an increased charge to cover the additional processing costs.

Countrystyle inspects all incoming loads. If the loads are found to be contaminated, Countrystyle reserves the absolute right to sort and charge additional costs (supported by photographic evidence) or to reject the load at the cost of the supplier.
