

WEEE & HAZARDOUS

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

Large Household & Commercial Appliances *e.g. fridges, freezers, cookers, microwaves, washing machines, vending machines & dishwashers*

Small Household & Commercial Appliances *e.g. vacuum cleaners, irons, toasters & clocks*

IT & Telecommunications Equipment *e.g. personal computers, copying equipment, telephones & pocket calculators*

Consumer Equipment *e.g. radios, TVs, hi-fi equipment, musical instruments & camcoders*

Lighting Equipment *e.g. straight/compact fluorescent tubes & high intensity discharge lamps*

Electrical & Electronic Tools *e.g. drills, saws, sewing machines & electric lawnmowers*

Toys, Leisure & Sport Equipment *e.g. electric trains, game consoles & running machines*

Medical Devices *e.g. (non infected) dialysis machines, analysers, medical freezers & cardiology equipment*

Monitoring & Control Equipment *e.g. smoke detectors, thermostats & heating regulators*

Automatic Dispensers *e.g. hot drinks dispensers & money dispensers*

HAZARDOUS WASTE

Everything is considered non-hazardous except for items that contain:

Asbestos

Chemicals *e.g. brake fluid or printer toner*

Batteries

Solvents

Pesticides

Oils (except Edible Ones) *e.g. car oil*

Equipment Containing Ozone Depleating Substances *e.g. fridges*

Hazardous Waste Containers

Hazardous Waste is usually identifiable by an orange and black warning symbol on the item.
